What is the family Support Resource Center?

We are an information and support resource for families and educators of children who receive special education services through Kent County Public Schools, including infants and toddlers, preschoolers, and students who remain in high school until age 21. We are part of a network of centers around the state, supported by the Maryland State Department of Education.

Who are the children?

About 16% of Kent County students receive special education services. Their disability may be obvious, such as physical disability, or hidden, such as a learning disability like dyslexia. The majority spends most of their time in a general education classroom but may spend varying amounts of time each week with one or more specialists - for occupational therapy or extra reading help, for example. Other specialists may visit the home of an infant experiencing developmental delays or the preschool of a toddler who has difficulty speaking.

The Family Support Resource Center assists families of these children by offering programs, resources, and other assistance that can help them to become effective partners with specialists and teachers in the education decision-making process.
