- Ensure support for Maryland Infants and Toddlers Program





- Improve educator compensation and working conditions
- Institute new recruitment and professional development practices to create a more diverse educator workforce
- Establish a new career ladder to improve professional practice and student performance
- Implement more comprehensive in-service training and professional development



College and Career Readiness

- Provide students with resources necessary to achieve reading proficiency by the end of grade 3
- Develop an aligned instructional system with supports necessary to keep students on track to be college and career ready (CCR)
- Establish pathways for CCR and non-CCR students in grades 11 and 12

- Provide more support for English learners, low income, and special education students
- Support community schools and provide wrap-around services to schools with high concentrations of poverty
- Coordinate community supports to meet student behavioral health needs
